- All housing

# CANCELLATION

All future payments will be  
effectively non-refundable!!

Program Fee Amount due if cancel:

- Before November 4<sup>th</sup> ~ lose \$500 deposit
- After November 4<sup>th</sup> ~ lose 50%
- After November 21<sup>st</sup> ~ lose 100%
- Flights are non-transferable & only partially refundable

# Travel permission, visas, and passports

- All US citizens **MUST** have a US passport valid for three months beyond the date of return
- All non-US passport holders acquiring visas: please email us visa confirmations.
- US Passport holders: Program will purchase ETA (Electronic Travel Authority) on your behalf to travel to NZ and AUS.
- Note that you are traveling as a “Tourist” **NOT** on a “Student visa” nor a “Training visa”

# Assorted tips and info

- Travel light! Suitcases and personal belonging must be acceptable for domestic flights. NZ and AUS airlines take this very seriously! Take note of all airline weight restrictions.
- Mastercard & Visa are widely accepted. American Express & Discover are not.
- Always have cash handy (recommend around \$100)
- Staying in touch: Can obtain a local SIM card or just use free wifi based apps. Some cell phone carriers will have reasonable data plans that will work in AUS and NZ.
- Keep watch of your bags, wallets, laptops, cell phones, passports, etc.! Theft is just as common in all three countries as it is here in Atlanta.

- You have still not been 'officially' accepted to the Pacific Program
- Be ready for Post Decision Questionnaires & Assessments
  - Mandatory OIE online pre-departure orientation

  - Personal Info Questionnaire
  - Roommate Questionnaire
  - Pay attention to Emails and to Atlas!
